LEGAL NOTICE of PUBLIC HEARING

Pursuant to Section 406 of the Town Charter, a public hearing will be held by the Board of Selectmen on Wednesday, December 1, 2010 at 7:20 P.M. in the Public Library to provide residents the opportunity to comment both orally and in writing on the revisions to ordinance Section 12-2(a) and 12-2(d), as it pertains to swimming in quarries:

RESOLVED, that Code of Ordinances Chapter 12 "Offenses and Miscellaneous Provisions" Article I "In General" Section 12-2 [Page 782] be revised as follows (*revised language in bold italics*):

Sec. 12-2. Swimming, underwater swimming or diving in quarries prohibited.


- (a) ***Except as provided herein***, it shall be unlawful for any person to swim or bathe in any quarry within the town.

...

[NEW] (d) ***EXCEPTION: The provisions of this article shall not apply to the operations on the premises known as the North and South Quarries in accordance with the agreement between the Town of Portland and Lessee, "Brownstone Exploration & Discovery Park, LLC."***

A copy of the revised ordinance is on file in the Town Clerk's office and is available for public inspection.
