PORTLAND IS GOING GREEN WITH SINGLE STREAM

What is single stream recycling?

Single stream recycling allows all your recyclables to be placed in one bin – NO MORE SORTING!

What exactly can be single-streamed?

Newspapers/Brown Paper Bags/Magazines/Catalogs/Telephone/Soft Cover Books
Junk Mail/Envelopes (all types)
Paper
Paperboard (cereal/tissue boxes)
Cardboard
All plastic items, numbers 1-7
Glass Bottles/Jars (any color)
Metal Cans (tin/steel/aluminum)

How do single stream items get recycled?

The Town of Portland delivers all single stream recyclables to the Willimantic Waste Recycling Facility. Their automated system processes and separates all recyclables into sellable end products, such as newspaper, mixed paper, cans, aluminum cans, soda bottles, milk jugs, etc. Check out www.williwaste.com and click on recycling to take a tour of the process.

Antifreeze
Store in a clean sealed container.
\$1.25/gallon

Automobile & Truck Tires
Remove from rims.
\$5.00/car tire
\$15.00/truck tire



Used motor oil
Drain in used oil container. Do not mix with any other liquids.

Batteries
(Car, boat, or tractor) Place in battery bins.

Charities of Hope – Clean, gently used clothing. No rags, torn or broken articles. Bag items & place in box.

Propane Tank Disposal - \$10.00

Compost & Brush

Leaves, grass and rakings.
No stumps or plastic bags.
Brush – No larger than 4" in diameter

Freon Appliances

Refrigerators, air conditioners, dehumidifiers & freezers
\$15.00

Bulky Waste

Roofing & building materials, wooden furniture & mattresses.
\$120.00/ton

Garbage

All garbage must be put in Portland "Pay Per Bags." Blue or green plastic bags with ties are sold in three sizes:
Small (15 gallon) \$1.00
Medium (30 gallon) \$4.00
Large (45 gallon) \$5.00
Bags are available at the Recycling Center, Town Hall & Tri-Town Foods.
Transfer Station Permits are \$20.00 and are valid through June 30, 2011. Permits must be affixed in the lower right hand corner passenger side of the windshield.
