On Monday October 17 we held a "Ground-breaking Ceremony" for the Park Pavilion that is being built at the Riverfront Park, located on Brownstone Avenue. The pavilion site has been staked out and the contractor will begin clearing this week.

Members of the Brownstone Quorum, Parks and Recreation, Planning and Public Works have been working on this project for the past year. The town was awarded a \$200,000 STEAP grant for the pavilion, which should be completed by the beginning of December.

The Riverfront Park, which has remarkable views of the Connecticut River, is beautifully maintained by members of the Brownstone Quorum. It is a great place to bike, run, walk or simply sit at one of the picnic tables made by the Youth Adventure Camp. With the addition of the pavilion we will be able to host townwide picnics, concerts and other large gatherings. Thank you to everyone involved for helping with this great project.
