#### 1. Call to Order

#### 3. Accept the Minutes of May 9, 2022 Meeting

#### 4. Review Focus Group Thoughts

- Notes were provided from the focus groups that Lou Pear and Charles Britton met with. At the time of this meeting they had met with 6 focus groups including staff from all the schools, and a joint PTO group.
- The consensus of the groups includes: reduce elementary schools to one or two, sell Gildersleeve School, one school is too large, grade configuration varies among the groups, and these groups were mixed as to where to place grade 6. Parents like that 6<sup>th</sup> grade has recess.
- At each focus group meeting the consensus is that whichever model is selected that a structured separation of 5& 6<sup>th</sup> grade students from Pre-K to 3 students occur. Any facility modification should create high quality academic space, contribute to a positive school climate, prioritize the health & safety of students & staff, improve air quality(HVAC), energy efficient, include capacity for enrollment increases, and Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) compliant, to name a few. These will be addressed in the Ed Spec that will be completed during this process.
- Charles Britton explained that he asked the Board of Selectmen for an extension for the committee report that is due June 30, 2022 and received the extension to October, 2022.

- 6 more focus group meetings have been scheduled in July and there will be a presentation at the Board of Education meeting in August
- The committee suggested that focus group meetings be held at Bartlett Hill, Quarry heights, Grandview Terrace and with the Lions/Exchange clubs
