

AN IMPORTANT PUBLIC SERVICE MESSAGE ABOUT PORTLAND TRANSFER STATION OPERATIONS



As we continue to monitor the situation of COVID-19, we want to express to all of you that we are staying focused on the health and safety of both our employees and valued residents. Below is an update on the changes we are making including health and safety precautions we have and continue to take at the Portland Transfer Station:

IMPROVEMENTS HAVE BEEN MADE TO PROTECT OUR EMPLOYEES AND THE PUBLIC.

The scale will reopen on Friday April 3rd and Trash Bags can be purchased in the scale office.

Payment transactions will be conducted through the window in the scale office.

The hand sanitizer provided outside the building MUST BE APPLIED before entering.

Kindly use checks for payment when possible to avoid the spread of contamination from cash.

Employees have been trained to wipe down surfaces between each transaction. Employees will use gloves when needed and have been asked to refrain from assisting the public in a direct manner with loading and unloading. <u>If you are</u> <u>unable to do this on your own, we ask that you come back when precautions</u> <u>have subsided.</u>
