Monday October 20th – Sunday November 2nd: Early Voting at Portland Town Hall – 33 East Main Street. 10:00 AM – 6:00 PM (Extended hours on October 28th & October 30th: 8:00 AM – 8:00 PM)

Tuesday November 4th: Election Day – Polls are open from 6:00 AM until 8:00 PM at the Portland Middle School, 93 High Street.

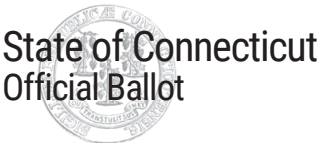
